

Message to our members, from the
Rodrigue Families Association Board of Directors

Dear members of the Rodrigue Families Association, we are all facing an exceptional situation with the current global coronavirus pandemic, and we hope that you are safe and in good health.

In accordance with the directives from the Government of Quebec concerning gatherings during this crisis, and wishing to reduce the risk of spreading the coronavirus, the Rodrigue Families Association Board of Directors had to take the following decision, with regret. This supersedes what has already been published in the Le Rodrigue-s/z newsletter and on our website :

Given

- **the current state of the global coronavirus pandemic,**
- **the increasing spread of this virus in Quebec and particularly in the Estrie region,**
- **the closure of the J. Armand Bombardier Museum of Ingenuity in Valcourt for an indefinite period,**
- **the fact that a significant number of members who participate in our gatherings and our Annual General Meetings (AGM) are from the population most at risk of contracting this virus,**
- **the uncertainty concerning a date of resolution of this situation and the reopening of said museum,**

the Rodrigue Families Association Board of Directors, at a meeting on March 28, 2020, decided to postpone its annual gathering and AGM, previously scheduled for May 23, 2020, in Valcourt, QC, to an unknown future date.

You will be notified of a new date for the gathering when the situation permits.

The Association's treasurer will contact members who have already registered for the gathering to discuss reimbursement arrangements.
